- Point out the blends and try to think of other words that start with the same blend.
- Try to think of words that rhyme (smash, bash, crash etc).
- Point out the changing vowel sounds and how the long vowel sounds are made (ee).
- Discuss the meaning of the words and try to think of a sentence containing the word.
