Or another celebration/festival</p> <p>Write a message and sign with your name.</p>	<p>To help celebrate Halloween, can you design a costume you can go trick or treating in?</p> <p>Draw a picture of your costume and label with keys words to explain;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Who you are dressed as.</li> <li>• The different features of your costume.</li> <li>• What your costume is made from.</li> </ul>  <p>Extension; write (in sentences) about the inspiration for your costume - where did you get the idea and why do you like it?</p>	<p>Many festivals and celebrations use light as a symbol.</p> <p>Can you find out which celebrations do this and why?
