What is life like for people living in Greenland? Explain your answer, use the internet to help. This can be a written piece or completed as a diagram e.g.; spider diagram.

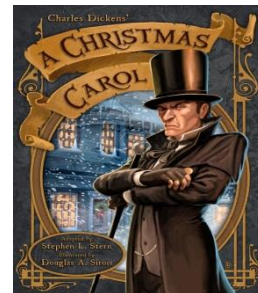
Fact file
