

This is our homework grid for the Spring Term 1. The activities are all linked to our topic or things we will be learning about throughout the half term.

I would like you to choose one piece from the homework grid each week. Please bring your homework in to be checked on **Thursdays**.

There will be resources to support activities provided in the pack.

Activity 1:

Design a poster for what to do in an emergency.



Activity 2:

Look at the special clothes that people wear in emergency related jobs—why must they wear them?

Choose one emergency related job and draw a picture of their uniform; add labels to show why it is important.



Activity 3:

Design a balanced meal—think about the healthy eating groups.

Draw pictures/use photos to show how you have made your meal and write simple instructions.



Activity 4:

Create your own emergency services vehicle. Think about its features; sirens, hosepipes, bright colours, lights etc.

Use junk materials to make your vehicle.



Activity 5:

Make and write a thank you card for someone who has helped you. If you can not think of someone who works in the Emergency Services, you could think of a family member or friend.



Activity 6:

Make an information booklet for your local community emergency services. Who are they? Where are they? And how do you contact them?

You could use the internet to help you.



Activity 7:

Draw a picture of someone who has helped you. Write some sentences to explain what they did and how they helped you.



Activity 8:

Design and make/draw a first aid kit.

Label it to explain what items you have chosen and why.



Activity 9:

Plan a visit to an emergency services department—tell me where you would like to go and why. If you put forward good ideas we will go on the visit.
