













This week we have enjoyed lots of hands on activities in Maths learning about lines of symmetry. We have made different shapes with plaster scene and drew lines of symmetry in the sand. We also have been on a shape hunt to find the matching shape to complete the correct line of symmetry. In Literacy this week we have been making predictions about our new book. We have been looking at different pictures from the book and asking questions.

During Science this week we have been investigating if a car would travel faster down a ramp made out of different materials. We discussed how to make it a fair test and built a ramp out of plastic and cardboard. We found that the car went faster when using the material cardboard!
